Unfortunately during the past year the Management Committee has been without a Chairman or vice Chairman. The Committee are therefore very grateful for the work Dolly Howes our Booking Clerk and Julie Lincoln our Cleaner have carried out in the day to day running of the village hall.

Meetings have been chaired by myself, the Thurton PC representative and Robert Todd our Chairman.

The Chairman and Vice Chairman posts are still vacant together with that of Secretary and Treasurer.

If these vacancies remain vacant, the future management of the village hall will be compromised. Ashby St Mary and Thurton PC's will need to deal with the situation in the coming year. On a positive note the village hall is being used regularly for group meetings together with other bookings by individuals for particular events.

The Hall finances are in good order but increasing maintenance work on the village hall will be a drain on these funds. The 100 club continues to raise additional finance, but now needs further support. At present there are 19 tickets unsold.

Aviva with their Community Group are helping us by providing labour to decorate the hall on 20th May 2015.

The AGM of the Village Hall & Playing Field Management Committee is to be held on Thursday 21st May 2015 and all parishioners are welcome to attend, especially if they are willing to help in the future management of the Village Hall.
